

City Of Red Bluff Building Department Responsibility & Goal

Your Building Department staff is assigned with the life, limb, and safety responsibility of each individual and shall always keep you as our highest priority while conducting each inspection, and Code Compliance.

We accomplish this task by being the responsible Department for Plan Intake and the distribution of these to other City Departments. (*Specific Fire Alarm and Sprinkler Design plans are the direct responsibility of the City Fire Chief and Fire Marshal*) These plans are checked for Code Compliance of all State and City Codes and commented on by Fire, Planning, Public Works as well as the Building Department. By working as a unit with the other Departments, all present codes are addressed as they pertain to each Department for compliance. This assures our continued goal of the enforcement of life, limb, and safety requirements from each aspect of our daily lives. During Plan Check, the Building Department will address the design of structural and fire resistant construction as well as the plumbing, electrical, mechanical, means of egress, energy, grading and accessibility requirements. These requirements are based on the 2001 California Building Codes as designed and approved by vote of The California Building Standards Commission and our California State Legislature. At the point of approval, a mandate is set by the California State Legislature for enforcement.

We are free to discuss any of your questions simply by a phone call from you to our Building Department. Please contact us at the following Phone numbers to set an appointment. Hours are 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday to Friday. We inspect on Saturdays, except 3 day holiday weekends, from 7:00 am to 3:30 pm. There is no office access on Saturdays.
