Tehama County Welding Shop
AB109 Program

The Cattail Art Project
(Typha Latifolia)

The Tehama County Welding Shop would like the opportunity to create the following piece of art for the City of Red Bluff as described in the summary provided. The details and design are subject to change, but shall not differ far from the concept proposed.

Keeping in mind that fabricators are trainees, and some creativity by each individual participating may enhance this art project.

Basic design and concept: The structure will be approximately twelve to fourteen feet high, span a width from eight to ten feet wide. Three elongated leaves will protrude from the surface with a slight arch reaching outward from the center. The leaves shall be three sided approximately twelve inches at the base reducing in size as they rise.

A flower six feet to seven feet long in the non-flowering state shall be slightly off center reaching skyward with a sharp pointed head just above.

A dragonfly approximately three feet wide, and three feet long shall be placed on the furthest outside leaf in a natural state. This dragonfly shall be at least eight feet from the ground surface.

A caterpillar two and a half feet long, and four to six inches in diameter shall be on the opposite side on the furthest outward leaf. Note: This may be replaced by a ladybug that's equal in size.

Materials: The leaves shall be made of 3/16" raw steel with 1"x 1" square tubing bracing within.


The flower will be a six inch pipe 1/8" thickness with 2" pipe 3/16" in thickness used for a stem.

The dragonfly body will be a 3" diameter pipe tapered. The wings outline will be 1/2" solid steel rod, and 1/4".

The caterpillar body will be 1/8" pipe.

Color: Currently the structure will remain in its metal state with a clear coat applied.


