E. STAFF REPORTS

1. Recreation Report

Supervisor Hurton reported that attendance has increased for kids programs. 38 children attended the recent Animal Camp, including more than a dozen low income kids whose fees were covered through CCRE or Cal-Works. Lead Recreation Coordinator, Erin Luevano, was able to collect fees in advance, in part due to a new online registration system she developed. The fees collected were able to cover all supplies, presenters and supervisory staff, and will contribute to program development and promotion.

Supervisor Hurton reported that the Volleyball championship tournament and the new softball league formats have been well received.

Community members have expressed interest in pickleball. We have equipment, at the community center. The corp yard fashioned some poles for use in the community center, so when community members are ready, a league can be formed.

Director Henz described the plans for boat ramp improvement at River Park. He hopes to see work on the temporary ramp begin this year. The project is estimated to take 5 years.
