D. Current Business

1. Dog Park

Another location, across from Diamond Park, was
discussed for the dog park and Bruce Henz brought
a map showing this other location. Bob Martin has
been working with the Henley's to decide the best
location and possible methods of funding. Martin
reported that he had Aquarium & Pets, Home Depot
and local contractors committed to helping with the

project. Gerry Reyes suggested having businesses buy billboards to hang at the park as a method of fundraising and Suren Patel suggested doing a program similar to “Adopt a Highway” where different businesses can become responsible for certain sections of the park. Potential ways to support the ongoing costs of maintaining the park (i.e. Cost to water, land maintenance, buying doggy bags, picking up dog feces) was also discussed. One suggestion, made by Bob Martin, was to frontload the project by collecting and raising a large amount of money in the beginning of the project. Bruce suggested taking the project in front of City Council soon to let them know what is being worked on and to hear their concerns.

Amanda Bline presented the recreation activities taking place in April, May and June.
