D. STAFF REPORTS

Recreation Report: Shaffer reported:

- City Council voted 4-1 to close the McGlynn City Pool for the 2020 summer season due to the virus. Shaffer reported that the funds cannot be carried over but was assured by Sandra Ryan, Finance Director, that funds would be made available next year to reopen the pool.
- Department of Education announced that they will not be providing any programs this summer. Fun Zone falls into the same category of reopening and providing kids programs as the SERF program.

- Torres recommended that we contact our Fun Zone parents and let them know to CCRE or Family Child Care Home Network (FCCHN) for available resources summer daycare.
- Mayor Eyestone reported that the proposed City Pars Ordinances were on the April 4th City Council agenda. Eyestone was assured by City Manager Rick Crabtree that the proposal will be on the City Council June 2nd agenda.
