1. Dog Park

2. Monthly Recreation Report

Amanda Bline reported that both men's basketball and women's volleyball have started. There are 12 basketball teams and 13 volleyball teams. She also mentioned that someone had the idea of having an adult dodgeball tournament

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and that that is something she will look into. Amanda and the Community Center staff are also working on a code of conduct for activities taking place there to help avoid any future conflicts.

3. Budget Planning Review

Amanda Bline gave a presentation on the Recreation budget and how it is formed. She explained the different revenue accounts, where they come from, and what expenditures they covered.

E. Other Business

Bob Martin mentioned the idea of the Parks and Recreation department holding a swap meet for car enthusiasts and collectors. Bob thought that this project could bring in roughly \$10,000 but would take about 8 months of planning to have it be successful. Bruce Henz suggested Bob talk to Scot Timboe, the City Planning Director, about the project.
