4.2 Weed Abatement / Goats

Information

Goat contractor was contacted to discuss various items of concerns that had been presented to Airport Manager:

- Distance of fence from runways and taxiways were reaffirmed
- Practice good general housekeeping to prevent fugitive debris from storage area
- Prohibition of mud deposits tracked onto taxiway from herd support vehicles
- Only minimum necessary herd support implements are to be stored on airport property
