3.1 Fixed Base Operator (FBO) – Gary Walker Informational

3.2 Vina Helitack Base Temporary Relocation Informational

Vina Helitack Base has started their temporary relocation to KRBL while they complete the demolition and reconstruction of their new

facility in Vina. They will operate out of PJ Helicopter's hangar, 2000 Trainor, on the east/west taxiway. A full presentation by CalFire will be made at next Commission meeting.

3.3 Damaged Taxiway Light **Informational**

On February 21, Commissioner Moore informed Scott Miller of a damaged taxiway light at the intersection of Taxiways A and C. It was confirmed that the light was completely destroyed with only wiring and base remaining. Globe, housing, and post were not located. Staff will be replacing when parts are available. No one has come forth claiming responsibility.

3.4 FAA Authorization Debate Moves Forward **Informational**

On Tuesday, House Transportation and Infrastructure Committee Chairman Bill Shuster (R-PA) announced that he will be ending his push to privatize Air Traffic Control

(ATC), meaning that the pathway to pass a Federal Aviation Administration (FAA)

Reauthorization as surfaced. The House version of the bill, or H.R. 2997, had stalled as lawmakers had concerns over ATC privatization. Additionally, the Senate Commerce, Science, and Transportation Committee has drafted their own version of the legislation, S. 1405, but has not been voted out of committee. The current extension is set to expire on March 31. It is anticipated that Congress will pass another short-term extension into June or July and aim to pass a reauthorization during the extension period. *Source; **ASCE Government Relations Newsletter March 2***
