#### **4.1 IASCO Congestion in Pattern Informational**

The Airport Manager had an impromptu meeting with one of IASCO's instructors while outside of RBL's terminal recently. Items discussed were topics listed in letter provided to previous IASCO management in June. Contact information was exchanged, and steps are being made to arrange a meeting between new IASCO management and RBL instructors.

#### **4.2 Designating September as Aviation Month Informational**

At January's Commission Meeting, it was elected to recommend to City Council that

September be recognized as Aviation Appreciation Month to coincide with the annual Fly-in at RBL. As the September 4<sup>th</sup> Council Meeting was canceled, the Proclamation reading will be made during the next scheduled Council meeting on September 18<sup>th</sup>. Council meetings start at 18:00.

## **5. New Business**

### **5.1 General Housekeeping at RBL Informational**

Recently, some general housekeeping has been conducted at RBL. City Public Works staff has provided additional mowing of the infield south of the wash slab and Fire Department crews have used string trimmers around certain hangars and on the street side near Beaver Avionics. The City is conducting a trial collaboration with Green Waste of Tehama County to provide “sweeping” services of the taxiways and ramp areas, including around the Compass Rose.

## **5.2 First Responder Drive Training**

### **Informational**

The week of September 3<sup>rd</sup> found the eastern end of the East-West taxiway fairly busy. Both the Fire Department and Police Department utilized the far end as an emergency vehicle training course. Each department set up traffic cones to delineate a desired course or obstacle avoidance simulation. The effected taxiway hangar operators were previously contacted, and each department was mindful to cease operations when any aircraft needed to taxi past.

## **5.3 The Return of the Goats**

### **Informational**

On September 5<sup>th</sup>, Western Grazers returned with their goats and set up between the north end of the runway and Luther Road. They will at RBL for about two weeks, and then be relocated to another site in the hills.
