1. **Approval of Minutes**

Schuler motioned to approve the January 14, 2015 minutes and Chamblin seconded the motion.

2. Citizen's Comments

Rob Schmid reminded the commission of a discussion from a year ago about supplying electricity to the hangars and he asked if there was any progress made.

Henz said the airport had a very limited budget and this year there is just enough money for the restaurant and some money was set aside for some possible environmental studies that may be required from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA).

Schmid asked if Henz found out if the box in front of Mitchell's Automotive was indeed a transformer.

Schuler said it wasn't a transformer and reminded the commission that it would cost \$1000 just for the deposit to hook up electricity and it would only go up substantially from there. She said just for a house, a transformer costs \$6000. She said it would be better to develop the front line hangars first.

Schuler reported the Tehama County Aviation Association is still complaining about the tarmac lights being too bright and asked if the Fire Department might be able to fabricate some shields.

Henz said he would talk with the city electrician about the shields.

3. Current Business

3.1 Fixed Base Operator Report

Henz reported on behalf of Cardan's that not much changed from the prior month except that they were able to purchase another load of fuel at a lower price.

3.2 Airport Fencing

Henz said he has been talking with Tom Jaharis, owner of Cardan's regarding the fencing requirements around the airport. Henz said he looked through FAA documents and talked to the city's airport consultant, Mead & Hunt and couldn't find any definite requirements except that the fence must be appropriate for airport security.

4. Old Business

4.1 Restaurant Rehab

Henz outlined the restaurant project, he said the design component should be complete by March 2, 2015 and hopes to have a construction estimate by March 9, 2015. Once a construction estimate is available, he has to put the project out to bid, and hope the bids are within the funding allowance.

4.2 Airport Developments

Henz reported that PJ Helicopters have started the permit process for the hangar they are building on Trainor and Anderson Streets.
