1. Commissioner's Approval of Minutes

2. Citizen's Comment

3. Current Business

3.1 Fixed Base Operator (FBO) – Cardan Aircraft Services

Gary Walker, Fixed Base Operator, said that things are busy, but going well. Mr. Walker reported that someone had damaged the South Gate card reader during the day by someone, and no one saw what happened. Chairperson Moore asked if it was fixed.

Mr. Miller said that he had city crews fix it the next day and it was in working order.

3.2 Appointment of Expired Commissioner Seats

Scott Miller, Airport Manager said that there were 3 applicants that were announced at the City Council Meeting for Airport Commission. None of the candidates were present for questions, so the council elected the incumbents Robert Moore, and Lynn Chamblin.

3.3 “New” Building at the east end of east/west taxiway

3.4 Aviation Month

Mr. Miller received an email from Alliance for Aviation Across America requesting a resolution from City Council to issue a Proclamation of Aviation Month. Commissioner Schuler asked if they were Non-Profit and wanted to see the email from Scott. Mr. Miller said he would send it to all of the commissioners.

4. Old Business

4.1 Contact with Glasair regarding Potential Relocation

Commissioner, Robert Moore, has had no additional contact with Glasair. He has tried several times to get them to call him back and they have not responded.

Mr. Miller said that Mr. Gunsauls was interested in helping with Glasair coming to Red Bluff.

4.2 Beacon Visibility

Mr. Miller said due to some pilot comments of difficulty seeing the Beacon, he had flown with Ken Johnson around various areas to experience the visibility of the Beacon. Approach visibility from a north vector was difficult, as well as a particular vector from the Wal-Mart Distribution Center. Mr. Miller said that Corning, and Redding were also difficult to pick up as well. Mr. Miller said he would like to continue researching the issue. Mr. Moore said that he could not see the Beacon at 3,000 ft. but when he dropped to 2,100 ft. it came into sight.

4.3 Leaks at Restaurant

Scott Miller, Gary Walker, and City Staff investigated the restaurant ceiling and the upstairs vacant unit and there were no new leaks or any other recent evidence that it had been leaking during the last storm.

5. Closing Comments

Mr. Moore questioned Scott if the goat contractor is allowed to get water from the Hydrant. Scott said that

he is allowed. Scott also said that he had a few issues to talk to the Contractor regarding his truck on the taxi way. Mr. Cappello asked Scott to make sure he doesn't track mud and rocks on the runway.

Scott Miller also mentioned that the Contractor had renewed his contract for another year with the City to continue the weed abatement service.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:05 p.m.
