- 6.2 Election of Commissioner for Consultant SOQ Panel Action
 On December 17, 2019, the City Council approved the advertisement for Request for Qualifications (RFQ) to select an Airport Consultant. As a condition of the FAA's AIP eligibility, airport sponsors must have an airport consultant which has been selected through a process outlined in FAA's AC150/5100-14E. The RFQ was released on December 19th and SOQ's are due by January 15, 2020. The selection committee consisting of City staff and one member of the Airport Commission, will conduct a Qualifications Based Selection process of the SOQ's, and if necessary, conduct interviews the week of January 20, 2020.

Recommended Action; Nominate and elect a Commissioner to serve on the selection panel.
