4. **Current Business**

4.1 Fixed Base Operator (FBO) – Gary Walker

5. Old Business

5.1 Report of Homeless Executive Meeting

Commissioner Robert Moore informed the Commissioners of the homeless executive meeting he attended. He presented the commissioners with a copy of the Request for Expressions of Interest - Vista Way Navigation Center and Facility Operations. Mr. Moore explained that they had talked about how the Homeless Shelter was going to run, the security, etc. Mr. Moore asked for the City to make copies of the draft documents that he received at the meeting for anyone interested. 6.2 Recommendation of Parking Resolution

Public Works Director Kampmann presented the proposed parking resolution for on-street parking as requested by 1445 Vista Way. She reviewed the current parking restrictions and the city code that allowed for the Council to modify parking on a case by case basis. Commissioner Schmid asked for CCR's clarification for parking and Mrs. Kampmann shared that per the CCR's that on-street parking was not allowed but also informed the commission that the city does not control the CCR's. Commissioner Schuler mentioned that the CCR's are there for a reason and that the county should be following those regulations. Commissioner Moore made a motion to not support on street parking.
