3. **Current Business**

3.1 Fixed Base Operator (FBO) – Gary Walker

Things are going well. Gary also informed the Commissioners they are having issues with coyotes. He also informed the commissioners that when the power was shut off by PG&E due to the Stoll Fire, it shut their fuel pumps off while they were fueling the firefighting helicopters. Airport Manager, Scott Miller said he is working with Gary to come up with a solution to fix this issue when the power goes out. Commissioner Dave Cappello asked Gary what the resolution

with the power issue is going to be because anytime there is a fire, PG&E will have to turn the power off. Mr. Walker said he was working on that issue with the Airport Manager to come up with a plan and then he would let him know.

Mr. Walker also mentioned that some War Birds recently flew into the Red Bluff Airport. They were having some mechanical issues. It took a few days, but they made repairs to the planes and then headed home.

4. Old Business

4.1 IASCO Operational Concerns at RBL

Scott Miller, Airport Manager informed the Commissioners that he met with Captain McConkey with IASCO and discussed issues with the students flying at the Red Bluff Airport. Mr. McConkey was very receptive and will communicate with his students to make things better. Mr. Miller will coordinate a meeting between IASCO instructors and RBL instructors to discuss operational and training improvements.

4.2 South Jackson Street Improvements

Mr. Miller let the commissioners know that there are some changes with the scheduling of the So. Jackson Street improvement. One of the buried gas lines under the street required additional investigation and pot-holing which pushed the schedule out an additional week. Also, there were a lot of positive comments from the public.
