Councilmember Rob Schmid asked where the contractor dumped the grindings from the Runway Rehabilitation.

Mr. Miller stated it the Contractors responsibility for an appropriate disposal location.

Dave Hall, hanger owner, expressed concern over the taxiway cracking and encouraged the Commissioners to address the problem.

3.2 Run-on Landings

Mr. Miller informed the Commissioners he had sent letters out to several agencies addressing the run-on landings and that they were no longer permitted. Council was addressed and City Manager Rick Crabtree is checking into FAA procedures.
