NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following City of Red Bluff Commissions have vacancies.

Planning Commission One, 3-year appointment which will expire December 31, 2019. This appointment is vacant due to a resignation. This appointment will begin when appointed at the January 15, 2019 City Council meeting. The Planning Commission meets the fourth Tuesday of every month beginning at 5:15 p.m. in the Red Bluff City Council Chambers.

Parks & Recreation Commission One, 1-year Student Representative Appointment beginning after appointment at the January 15, 2019 City Council meeting. The Parks & Recreation Commission meets on the second Wednesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. in the Red Bluff City Council Chambers.

Citizens who **volunteer** their time to serve on these commissions are required to complete and file with the City Clerks Office Statements of Economic Interest (Form 700). The California Fair Political Practices Commission provides that members of Boards and Commissions and Consultants to state and local government agencies may be required by a City's Conflict of Interest Code to disclose their personal financial interests if they make or participate in making governmental decisions that could affect their private financial interests.

The Red Bluff City Council will fill these vacancies by appointment and encourages all interested citizens to apply.
