SR36 EAST RED BLUFF PROJECT TO BEGIN CONSTRUCTION

Night Work Starts on Monday, April 2nd with some traffic delays.

(Redding) – Caltrans District 2 and its contractor Tullis, Inc. announce the construction of the East Red Bluff Pavement Rehabilitation Project on State Route 36. Improvements include repairs to the roadway, pavement replacement, sidewalks, and ADA-compliant curb ramps. The East Red Bluff project begins on SR36/Antelope Blvd. near Sale Lane, continues east towards the SR36/SR99 junction, and finishes on SR36E approximately 2.0 miles east of the junction.

Construction work will begin in the eastern half of the project, with sidewalk, driveway, and ADA curb ramp work. More extensive repairs will take place in the most heavily worn areas of the existing pavement by grinding and replacing deeper into the existing pavement. After concrete work is complete the existing pavement will be removed and replaced, to a depth of 2.5", with a rubberized asphalt pavement. Some sidewalks will be repaired and other areas will receive new sidewalks, ADA ramps, and driveways.

The majority of work is scheduled during night time, from 6 PM thru 6 AM. During portions of the project traffic delays from 15 to 20 minutes are anticipated. Caltrans thanks the public in advance for their patience and understanding.
