

**City Of Red Bluff**  
**Notice Of Adoption Of Mandatory Water Conservation Measures**  
**Effective June 1, 2015**

In order to comply with state water conservation mandates, the Red Bluff City Council has adopted Stage III Mandatory Water Conservation Measures, pursuant to City Code § 24.20.

Until further notice, the following water conservation measures are MANDATORY:

1. Landscape watering by any means is prohibited except on the following days between the hours of midnight and 8:00 am and again on the same day between the hours of 9:00 pm until midnight.
  - Customers whose street addresses end with an odd number may water only on Wednesday and Sunday and only within the permitted time period.
  - Customers whose addresses end with an even number may water only on Tuesday and Saturday and only within the permitted time period.
2. Refrain from allowing water run-off from any lawns, landscapes, or garden into adjoining streets, gutters, sidewalks, parking lot or alley.
3. Refrain from hosing or washing sidewalks, walkways, driveways, parking lots, or other hard surfaced areas.
4. Refrain from washing cars, boats, trailers, or other vehicles except by hose with a shutoff nozzle and bucket.
5. Equip any hose with a shutoff nozzle.
6. Promptly repair all leaks in plumbing fixtures, water lines, and sprinkler systems.
7. Equip ornamental fountains, ponds or lakes with a water recycling system.
8. All new construction must install low flow shower heads, low flush toilets, and faucet aerators.
9. Operators of restaurants must provide on each table a notice of water emergency and refrain from serving drinking water except upon specific request of a customer.
10. Operators of hotels and motels must provide in each room a notice of water emergency and the option not to have towels and linen laundered daily.
